3/4 Update from Lead Officer and workplan 2023/24

Our Annual Report has been well-received. SD did a lot of the work as there were commonalities across the three Berkshire West Healthwatch so it made sense in terms of capacity to work on the three together. Thank you to GB and CTW for reviewing.

We have a meeting with Amit Sharma, Chair of Berks West Primary Care Alliance, in early August to explore how we can work together on issues around public understanding and expectations for GP-led services. This will give direction and structure to the access to, and quality of, GP services workplan priority.

Pharmacies are increasingly on our radar as part of the issue.

We have received additional funding from NHSE via BOB ICB under the <u>Core20Plus5</u> Community Connectors programme to undertake a piece of work around teeth extractions in under 10s. The focus will be in Reading as the target is the most deprived areas in BOB.

Berks West Maternal Mental Health report has been published. We are working with the BOB ICB leads.

	 BOB ICB Transformation of <u>Continuing Healthcare</u> programme – we have been tasked with speaking to 6 people across Berkshire West who have been turned down for CHC funding to understand their experiences. The ICB are doing a survey of people in receipt of CHC funding. Dentistry for people with learning disabilities – to work with CLASP to do a survey with their members. Action: CTW to support this piece of work preparing the survey and/or meeting with the members.
	with their members. Action: CTW to support this piece of work preparing the survey and/or meeting
	We are taking a key role at a group of decision makers and stakeholders from the NHS/local authorities across BOB where actions to improve support for asylum seekers are being shared.
	SD commented that our activities aren't just about the big reports/pieces of work, it is as much about 'chipping away', speaking to the right people. The Annual Report reflects some of this.
5	Engagement activity
	Discussion about our marketing materials and that simply translating from English into another language won't necessarily be enough, we need to consider the context – knowledge and expectations around health and social care systems and what HW can do. Important to involve the community in the design and content of surveys, leaflets, etc. Noting that this is becoming more of an issue in Wokingham as now 18% of residents don't have English as their 1 st language.
	Action: to pick up as part of marketing task and finish group.
	Discussion about asking charities to add our information to their websites. This might cause confusion as could send people round in circles! We are on the Joy app.
	We are keeping records/photos of our engagement activity for the next Annual Report.
6	Enter and View
