1.	Welcome, apologies and introductions:

2.	Updates/information: The Advocacy People;
	Healthwatch Wokingham Borough; Healthwatch in
	Berkshire West:
	SD gave an overview of The Advocacy People and
	Healthwatch; history, how contracts work and
	Governance.
	AKC discussed current recruitment for staff and
	volunteers as MRP wanted to know more.
	AKC discussed our time so far in Wokingham as the new
	HW team, our current roadshow, meetings attended what
	we gain from those meetings and what those experiences
	have been like, as well as our statutory powers.
	GB asked why we did not attend the recent Wokingham
	Volunteer Fair. AKC spoke about staff and volunteer
	capacity, and the need for more notice of such events.



	There is a similar event taking place in September which we will be part of.	
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	Discussions around Community Ambassadors, NW gives	
	examples of how this could work with his contacts in	
	Twyford and other areas with events.	
3.	Governance and working together	
	GB queried "resolution of decision making." Papers state	SD
	that if the Group cannot make a decision it should then	
	go to The Advocacy People's Board. SD agrees it should	
	not go to this Board for final decision. She will review this	
	and talk to the Chair HW West Berks.	
	In the meantime, all members agreed that the 2	
	documents circulated could be uploaded to the website,	
	pending a full review.	
4.	Review of workplan	
	SD talks about the current work plan, how themes are ever	
	changing, how workplan themes are decided and how	
	the current plan is an external facing document.	
	All members agree that HW needs an internal version with	
	finer details; dates, measurements, achievements etc. SD	AKC
	talks about the Gantt chart is in progress. Members agree	
	that with this internal workplan, they can put their names	
	against projects and to share skills.	
	MRP emphasises the importance of being able to	
	measure performance. There were discussions around	
	added value, core messaging and what measuring	
	impact looks like (Theory of Change model Portsmouth	
	work with) which is key to HW work.	
	Discussions around type of feedback we receive, complex	
	cases, budgets, projects etc.	



	SD asks about a potential survey asking the local community what they think we should be focusing on as per HW Portsmouth & HW IoW. Members agreed that this should come later after more local residents know who we are. AKC talks about the Cost of Living as a theme to watch. Discussions around not all local communities being heard; AW talked about his work in deprived areas in Reading which we want to replicate in Wokingham Borough.	
5.	Planning for Enter and View	
	Discussions around the upcoming Enter and View, background and engagement. CTW gives feedback on the Enter and View survey she has been reviewing for GC. She advises to cut the down the survey further and to have one main focus rather than trying to put too much into the survey as results will be diluted.	GC
6.	Next steps, including upcoming meetings/events SD asked if any member would like to step forward as Chair as she does not wish the HW staff to be directing the Group. MRP said he can't commit until he knows what the Advisory Group work looks like.	
	GB said he is happy to step in to organise and chair the next meeting.	GB
	SD asked the Group about attending local Board meetings to represent HW Wokingham Borough and for backup to spread capacity. Group members need to know more information. AKC to send members a list of the external Board meetings.	AKC
